Format:

Title of PowerPoint. (Date created or updated). Unit Number. Lecture notes. Retrieved month date, year from West Coast Institute of Training Blackboard.

Example:

Law of Torts. (2011) HLTEN58. *Lecture notes*. Retrieved September 1, 2011 from West Coast Institute of Training Blackboard.

Example:

Head injury. (2008). *SICK! Diseases and disorders, injuries and infections*. [Online Edition] Detroit: UXL. Retrieved from Health and Wellness Resource Centre, via Infotrac. doi: DU2618720056

Referencing MIMS

MIMS	In-text reference	Reference List
MIMS (online)	Panadol can be given to("Panadol", 2010.).	Panadol. (2010). Retrieved fom MIMS Online
MIMS (print journal)	Interactions given are(Alphamox, 2010, p.223).	Alphamox. (2010). <i>MIMS</i> , 48(1), 223

Things to note:

Points we would like to highlight in the ECU 2011 Guide :

- Page 10
The volume number is italicised, but not the issue.
- Page 11
In the end-text reference, use 'p.' Or 'pp.' **only** for newspaper articles not journal articles. But you put the 'p.' in the In-text reference.
- Page 19
Webpages
There is no full stop after the URL
The title of page is not italicised in the end-text reference ... but the title of the web page in the in-text reference does have quotation marks.
