Format:

Title of PowerPoint. (Date created or updated). Unit Number. Lecture notes. Retrieved month date, year from West Coast Institute of Training Blackboard.

Example:

Law of Torts. (2011) HLTEN58. *Lecture notes*. Retrieved September 1, 2011 from West Coast Institute of Training Blackboard.

Example:

Head injury. (2008). SICK! Diseases and disorders, injuries and infections. [Online Edition] Detroit: UXL. Retrieved from Health and Wellness Resource Centre, via Infotrac. doi: DU2618720056

Referencing MIMS

MIMS	In-text reference	Reference List
MIMS (online)	Panadol can be given to("Panadol", 2010.).	Panadol. (2010). Retrieved fom MIMS Online
MIMS (print journal)	Interactions given are(Alphamox, 2010, p.223).	Alphamox. (2010). MIMS, 48(1), 223

Things to note:

Points we would like to hightlight in the ECU 2011 Guide:

- Page 10
 - The volume number is italicised, but not the issue.
- Page 11
 - In the end-text reference, use 'p.' Or 'pp.' only for newspaper articles not journal articles. But you put the 'p.' in the In-text reference.
- Page 19
 - Webpages
 - There is no full stop after the URL

The title of page is not italicised in the end-text reference ... but the title of the web page in the intext reference does have quotation marks.
